John Duffy (13), 12 Glasgow Road, Cambuslang, was the victim of a bathing tragedy in the River Clyde at Cambuslang yesterday afternoon. Along with two companions, he had been swimming in a deep pool opposite Cambuslang dyeworks, where bathers frequently, resort, when he got into difficulties and cried for help. One of his companions tried to assist him, while the other made for the bank and dashed to Orion Bridge to get further help. Meanwhile, Duffy was carried out by the strong current and disappeared. Two young men, who rushed to the spot, made unsuccessful efforts to recover the body, and subsequently the police arrived with grappling irons
