## A CAMBUSLANG SOLDIER KILLED

Intimation has been received from the War Office by Mrs Dunn, who resides at 9 Silverbanks Street, Cambuslang, that her husband, Private John Dunn, of the 1st Battalion Gordon Highlanders, died of wounds received on the battlefield on 13th March. Private Dunn went through the Boer War in the ranks of the 1st Durham Light Infantry, for which he received the silver medal and three clasps. He joined the 1st Battalion Gordon Highlanders on 1st September. He was home for a fortnight in January, but was again at the front in the beginning of February. Private Dunn was a miner, and was employed in Dechmont Colliery, Cambuslang, He leaves a widow and three children.
